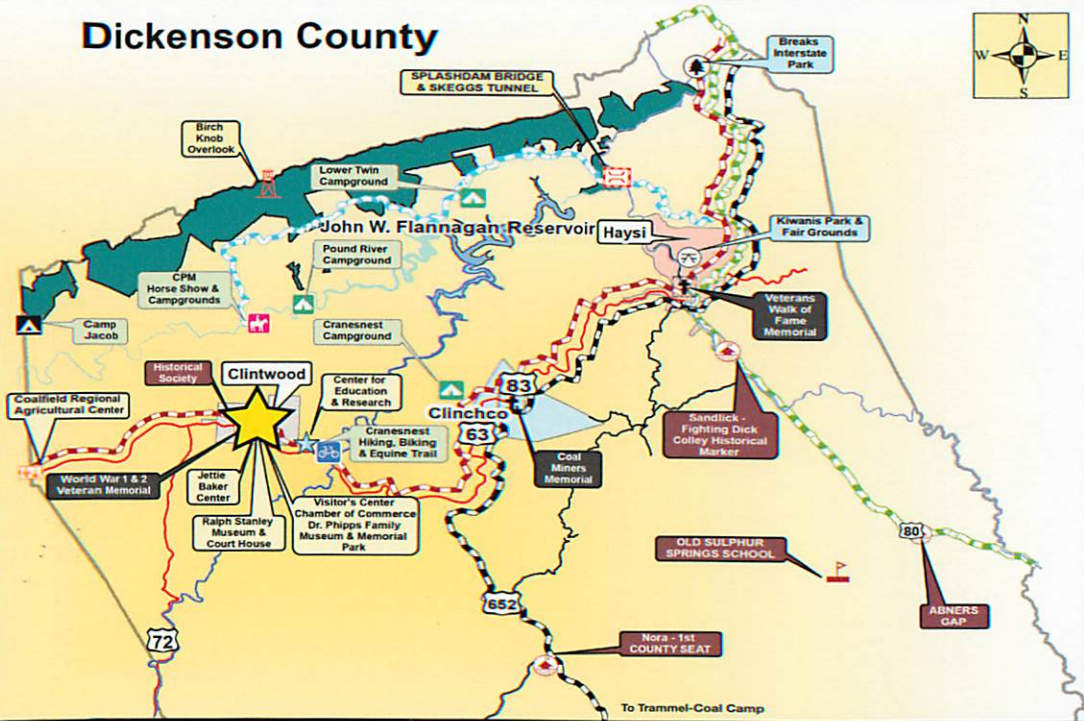
Dr. Rufus Phipps was a prominent doctor in Dickenson County and operated the Dickenson County Hospital from the 1920's to his death in 1951. Dr. Phipps made housecalls to many patients throughout the county. His wife Toni, two daughters, Carol Phipps Buchanan and Jean Lui Phipps lived in the home where the museum is now located. Carol Phipps Buchanan was the wife of John Chalkley Buchanan who was a Virginia State Senator and doctor. Dr. Phipps was the son of Mr. Columbus Phipps, the first Clerk of Dickenson County. The Columbus Phipps Foundation, located on Main Street in Clintwood aids students in Dickenson County with scholarships for college.

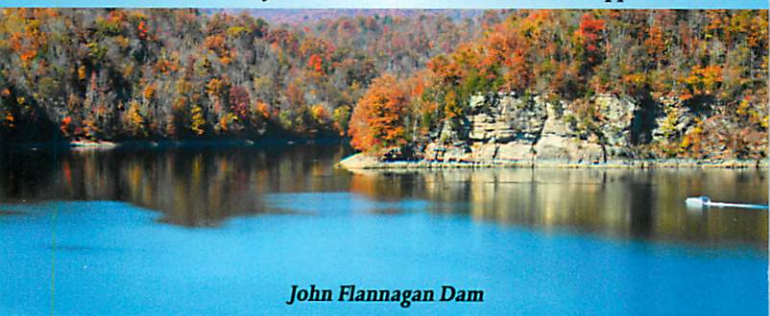
